**5. River Access Land – Drain and Access from Rose Cottage.**

Councillor Gambold had requested to speak on this item and he advised the Council that the garden of Rose Cottage was to be sold to 4 residents and that they would like to lay a land drain down the garden and connect this to the drain in the River Access Field. To enable the work to be completed the residents requested that the Parish Council grant access through the field to the contractors, in order to remove trees from the garden area and lay the land drain which would then connect into the drain in the River Access Field.

Councillors agreed in principal to this action being granted, provided a formal agreement is drawn up and agreed by each resident. A document is to be drawn up for each resident to sign, accepting liability for any damage or blockages which may occur in the future. Contractors may use the River Access Field as access to the garden of Rose Cottage provided the gate is locked at all times (when not being used) and that the land will be restored to its current state when the works are complete.
