Members of the Public are not permitted to speak at the Parish Council meeting unless they have notified the Clerk in writing at least two clear days prior to the meeting that they wish to speak on a specific business item on the agenda.

8. To discuss, agree action and consider authorising any expenditure for purchase of a new dog and waste bin at Lock House Lane car park, as proposed by Cllr Offler.
9. To discuss, agree action and authorise any expenditure regarding cleaning of the tennis courts, review of the tennis subscriptions and any further activity on the tennis courts, as proposed by Cllr Leveson.
10. To discuss, agree action and authorise any expenditure relating to the silver birch trees which run parallel with the back gardens of the bungalows down from the Village Hall, as proposed by Cllr Offler.
11. To discuss, agree any action and authorise any expenditure regarding Huntington Churchyard, as proposed by Cllr Wiseman.

12. To discuss, agree any action and authorise any expenditure regarding the Garden Village land transfer from Persimmons to Earswick Parish Council, as proposed by Cllr Wiseman.
13. To discuss, agree any action and authorise any expenditure relating to the City of York Council's proposed improvements to the A1237, as proposed by Cllr Wiseman.
14. To discuss and agree action regarding appointment of an Internal Auditor, as proposed by Cllr Jones
15. To discuss and agree any action regarding the possible extension of double yellow lines at the Strensall Rd end of The Village, as proposed by Cllr Wiseman.
16. To discuss and agree any action regarding the original entrance to the cottages at 113 Strensall Rd, and the building plot adjoining 121 Strensall Rd, as proposed by Cllr Offler.
